Upper Sandusky Exempted Village Schools Post Secondary Enrollment Options

Program:

The Post Secondary Enrollment Options program enables Upper Sandusky High School Students to enroll full or part time at colleges or universities around the area. This program is mainly for grades eleven and twelve, but depending on unique circumstances could involve ninth and tenth grade students.

Eligibility:

Upper Sandusky High School Students are eligible to participate in this program if he/she:

- Is accepted by a qualified institution
- Has discussed options with the HS Guidance Counselor
- Understands the responsibilities with the program

Options Available:

Option A: The student may elect at the time of enrollment to receive college credit **only** for the courses he/she takes while enrolled in Upper Sandusky High School. With this option the parent and/or student is responsible for the cost of tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials.

Option B: The student may elect at the time of enrollment for the course to receive both high school and college credit for the courses taken at the institution. With this option the cost of tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials will be paid by the Upper Sandusky Exempted Village School District.

Credits: Upper Sandusky High School Credits will be granted to those students electing to receive high school credit in the following manner:

- 4 semester credit hours = .8 high school credit
- 3 semester credit hours = .6 high school credit
- 2 semester credit hours = .4 high school credit
- 5 quarter credit hours = .660 high school credit
- 4 quarter credit hours = .533 high school credit
- 2 quarter credit hours = .260 high school credit

Grade Point Average:

Courses taken at the college level will be converted to high school credit with 4.5 grading scale just like the high school Advanced Placement classes. These courses will figure into the cumulative GPA only. These courses do not show on a nine weeks grade card, and do not figure in to the 9 weeks GPA
